A very important International Grapevine Conference (GBG2023) will be held on 21-24 August 2023 in Avanos, in the Cappadocia region, which is one of the most important tourism destinations in Türkiye and has a long history of viticulture. We have extended the deadline for early registration and abstract submission **until June 1, 2023**, to allow more participants to attend the "**XIII. International Conference on Viticulture, Genetics and Management**" (www.gbg2023.org).

- Present your studies on viticulture
- Have potential project partnership meetings with scientists from different countries and especially in Turkey
- To be informed about the progress of different sectors on viticulture/genetics/genomics/vineyard management
- See Türkiye's number one tourism region and its historical viticulture history

We strongly recommend that you hurry. August is the month when tourists show the highest demand for the Cappadocia region, and we recommend that you hurry up for registration and accommodation reservations. At the Conference, presentations of studies on wine, table and raisin grape breeding, genetics and management are welcomed. In addition to the studies on grapevine breeding and genetics, studies on the effects of global climate change on the viticulture sector will be among the priority topics of our conference. Also we accept the other grapevine researches and you can have chance to present them during the Conference.

Sponsorship agreements were made with 15 different institutions and organizations, and this number is expected to increase until the conference time. Also, during the Conference, this institution and organizations will make presentation of their activities in order to provide a suitable environment for potential project partnerships with participants. Apart from these, it is planned that different viticulture experts from different countries will make keynote presentations. In this context, 11 keynote presentations have been finalized and it is planned to reach 15/20 keynote presentations during the Conference time.

Abstracts continue to be submitted via the ISHS ROSA system and the number of abstracts is increasing day by day. Abstract submission date will be closed as of June 1, 2023 in order to allow time for reviewer evaluation of full texts.

Oral presentation opportunity will be given to anyone who wishes to make their presentation during the conference, depending on the number of abstracts. We will be especially help to young researchers to make oral presentations in order to have this experience.

Depending on the number of papers in the conference, a half or full day technical trip will be made. During the technical tour, it is planned to visit several important touristic regions, traditional vineyards, local varieties grown on calcareous soil, and a winery in the region.

In addition, for those who want to attend after a full-day post conference tour (including transportation, food and entrance fees) including many touristic places in the region is planned on August 25. We recommend that especially those who will visit the region for the first time should join this tour, which will be organized at an reasonable price.
